WHAT: The *Exploring Our Sense of Place* is an 8 session seminar series that includes 7 hikes with lectures by experts and special "reflective time" sessions, and a reception. (please see the schedule below)

WHO: Those who want to learn more about the River Park, strengthen their connection to nature, are able to hike at a relaxed pace for 3-4 miles, and are willing to make a commitment to attend at least 6 of the 8 sessions.

WHEN: The program will begin with a reception on Monday, September 27, 2010.

The tentative schedule is as follows:

Monday, September 27, 2010, 6:00-7:30 p.m.: Introductory reception at the Powerhouse in Del Mar

Saturday, October 2, 2010, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.: "River Park Overview" at Dudley's Bakery/Volcan Mountain

Saturday, November 6, 2010, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.: "Mammals & Tracking" at Santa Ysabel Open Space Preserve East

Saturday, January 8, 2011, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.: "Native Americans" at the San Diego Archeological Center/Clevenger Canyon North Trail

Saturday, February 5, 2011, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m.: "Birds" at the Joslyn Senior Center Rancho Bernardo/Bernardo Bay

Saturday, March 5, 2011, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m: "Geology and Chapparal" at the San Diego Archeological Center/Lake Sutherland

Saturday, April 2, 2011, 9 a.m.- 3 p.m: "Botany" at the Joslyn Sr. Center Rancho Bernardo/Piedras Pintadas

Saturday, May 7, 2011, 9 a.m.- noon: Graduation at the Scripps Institution of Oceanography

TUITION: \$250, which includes the two texts, course materials, and lectures by local experts on the topics. Participants must provide their own brown bag lunches and hiking supplies.

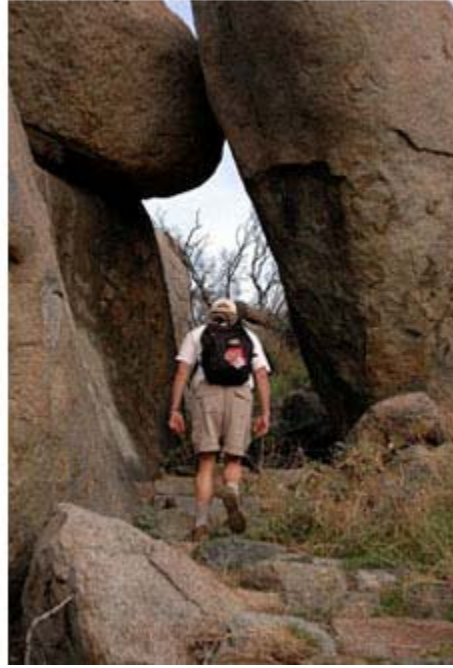
